This year, ESET will award three \$5,000 scholarships to women who are pursuing a college-level degree and aspire to a career in the cybersecurity field.

### **How do I apply?**

Complete the application and two essay questions below. Tell us what your dream job is and how you'll achieve it, as well as any special characteristics or accomplishments that set you apart from the crowd.

### **How do I qualify for the scholarship?**

You must be a female enrolled in or accepted to an accredited undergraduate or graduate program in the state of California, United States studying the field of cybersecurity. (The graduate/undergraduate program does not have to be a "cybersecurity" program; however, in your application you should make clear that you aspire to have a career in the cybersecurity industry.)

You must have a minimum cumulative 3.0 GPA.

You must be a US citizen or permanent resident with a permanent resident ID card.

### **What is the deadline for submission?**

Submissions will be accepted from March 15 through April 15, 2019 at 11:59 p.m. Pacific Time. Winners will be announced on May 1, 2019.

### **How do I submit my application?**

All essays and applications must be submitted to [US-scholarship@eset.com](mailto:US-scholarship@eset.com) with a subject line of "Women in Cybersecurity Scholarship".

Applicants must include a copy of an unofficial transcript or acceptance letter as proof of enrollment.

Applicants must include one letter of recommendation, signed by the recommending party.

Please attach them as a PDF or word document.

### **Do I need to know anything else?**

Essays may be submitted in English or Spanish.

Finalists must participate in a phone interview to be considered for the award.

Finalists may be required to supply additional personal or professional references.

Judging is conducted by a panel of ESET staff including cybersecurity experts.

Finalists may be asked to provide a photo of themselves, which may be used for promotional purposes.

Winner may be asked to join ESET in-person to receive the scholarship on May 3rd, at a cybersecurity event in San Diego, California, with expenses for travel and lodging paid by ESET. Ability to travel is not a requirement for the award, and your receiving the award is not contingent upon your ability to travel to accept the award in person.

If the application or essays are illegible, it will not be considered.

Immediate family members or dependents of ESET employees are not eligible to participate.

The winners will be informed by April 26, 2019 and will be notified by email and phone.
